



Glen Rose Nursing and Rehab Center has some exciting news on the visitation policy that we are happy to share. We will be opening visitation to 2 essential caregivers/family designated by the resident or responsible party. These essential care givers will be required to follow certain guidelines, and these will be as follows:

- They must have a negative COVID test no more than 14 days old
- They must be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 prior to entry
- They will be provided with full personal protective equipment (PPE) and training on proper use of PPE
- They will be escorted in and out of the facility.
- They may only visit resident one on one in designated area.
- Visits are by appointment only

Before and after each visit the designated visiting area will be deep cleaned, and residents and visitors will perform hand hygiene.

At this time, only essential visitors are allowed to visit with appointment, these appointments will be scheduled through administration. Visits will be limited to 45 minutes to promote equitable access by all residents and visitors and time for proper disinfecting between visits. Upon arrival, essential caregiver must provide ID and proof of negative COVID status. Essential care givers should be prepared to wear full PPE, including but not limited to gown, masks, gloves, face shields and goggles throughout the duration of their visit. Essential caregivers will also be required to complete education and post test provided by facility and HHS prior to first visit. Post test will have to be taken as proof of education completed.
